

MEMORANDUM

between

BAKU EURASIAN UNIVERSITY

(BAAU)

and

LIMITED LIABILITY PARTNERSHIP

"SCIENTIFIC PUBLICATIONS"

Baku Eurasian University, represented by the Rector Assoc. Prof. Sayavush Gasimov, acting on the basis of the Charter, and the **Limited Liability Company "Scientific Publications"**, represented by the founder Denis Sergeevich Pilipenko, acting on the basis of the Charter (hereinafter referred to as the "Parties"), aiming to develop cooperation in research and scientific-educational activities in the field of scientometrics and science, based on the belief that collaboration in the field of education and scientific research will contribute to increasing the quantity and quality of scientific publications and their placement in international scientometric databases, have agreed as follows:

Article 1

The parties will cooperate in the field of education, science, scientometrics and scientific research, observing the principles of parity and mutual benefit in accordance with the current legislation of each partner country.

Article 2

The parties will develop cooperation in the field of education, science, scientometrics and scientific research in the following areas:

- cooperation in the field of education, science, scientometrics and scientific research;
- information and organizational support of events held by the Parties, support for their preparation and implementation;
- information and consulting cooperation on the creation (writing) of scientific papers, articles and their placement in international scientometric databases;

Article 3

Cooperation between the Parties in the field of education, science, scientometrics and scientific research will be carried out by:

- exchange of information on scientific projects;
- joint organization and holding of scientific seminars, conferences and webinars;



- Exchange of information and scientific documents;
- Organization of scientific programs and courses that will be of mutual interest;
- Establishment of websites, projects, research centers, etc.

Article 4

The parties will promote common direct links. To achieve this goal, the Parties will exchange contacts of their representatives (trustees) to determine and subsequently implement areas of cooperation.

Article 5

Amendments and additions to this Memorandum shall be made by mutual written consent of the Parties and shall be formalized in protocols, and shall be an integral part of this Agreement.

Article 6

All disputes regarding the interpretation or application of the provisions of this Agreement will be resolved through consultations and negotiations between the Parties.

Article 7

The Memorandum enters into force from the date of its signing and will be valid for 3 (three) years from the date of its signing by the Parties.

The term of the Memorandum shall be automatically extended if one party fails to notify the other Party of its intention to terminate the Memorandum 30 (thirty) calendar days in advance.

Each Party may terminate the Memorandum at any time by giving thirty (30) calendar days written notice to the other Party.

This Memorandum defines the areas of cooperation and does not create any legal and financial consequences for the Parties.

Miscellaneous

The Parties separately stipulate that the conclusion of this Memorandum does not bind the Parties to any legal obligations, does not entail the emergence of financial obligations, and that the emergence of the latter requires the conclusion of separate agreements by the Parties.

This Memorandum is not a preliminary contract and cannot serve as a basis for the liability of the Parties for failure to comply with its provisions (none of the Parties will be



obliged to compensate the other Party, including (without limitation) damages, losses incurred by the Party in connection with the performance (non-performance), expiration or termination of this Memorandum). With respect to this Memorandum, neither Party shall be encumbered by the obligations or debts of the other Party or Parties, and neither Party shall act as an agent of the other Party or Parties without entering into appropriate separate agreements.

Each Party will bear its own costs arising from the performance of the terms of this Memorandum, except as otherwise provided under the relevant agreements, any information provided by the Parties to each other in writing or orally may not be transferred or disclosed to third parties without the written consent of the Party providing the information.
